

### WHERE TO FIND THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

Listed below are God's Ten Commandments as found in the Old Testament in Exodus 20:1-17. Next to each commandment is listed where they are repeated--either exactly or in principle--in the New Testament.

OLD TESTAMENT (Exodus 20:3-17)	NEW TESTAMENT
1. You shall have no other gods before me. (v. 3)	Matthew 4:10; Luke 4:5-8; 1 Corinthians 8:4-6
2. You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. (v. 4)	Acts 17:29; 1 John 5:21
3. You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name. (v. 7)	Matthew 6:9; 1 Timothy 6:1
4. Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. (v. 8)	Mark 2:27-28; Luke 4:16; Acts 17:1-2
5. Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you. (v. 12)	Matthew 15:3-4; 19:16-19; Mark 10:17-19; Luke 18:18-20; Ephesians 6:1-3
6. You shall not murder. (v.13)	Matthew 5:21-22; 19:16-18; Romans 13:9
7. You shall not commit adultery. (v. 14)	Matthew 5:27-28; 19:16-18; Romans 13:9
8. You shall not steal. (v. 15)	Matthew 19:16-18; Romans 13:9; Ephesians 4:28
9. You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. (v. 16)	Matthew 19:16-18
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor. (v. 17)	Romans 7:7; 13:9
